Orgalime Proposal for the European Commission Guidelines

Annex I, clause 6.2.

'The control devices for these movements must be of the hold-to-run type except where the carrier itself is completely enclosed'

What is unclear in the directive 2006/42/EC and has to be clarified?

The meaning of "the carrier itself is completely enclosed" is not clear.

Orgalime Proposal for the European Commission Guidelines:

"The carrier itself is completely enclosed" *should read: completely enclosed with walls, roof and doors on the carrier*". (See also other reference to doors on the carrier and roof in clauses 6.4.1 and 6.3.3).
